- 2.) Did you _____ the Gospel when you heard it? (Rom 10:9,10)
 - *This means you believe Jesus is the Messiah.
 - *You believe He died to pay the price for your sins.
 - *You believe He rose from the dead and will return.
 - *You believe He loves you and wants you to be saved.
- 3.) Did You _____ Jesus as Lord? (Rom 10:9,10)
 - * All who call on the Lord will be saved. (Rom 10:13)
 - *Confessions were public and usually occur during baptism. (Acts 2:38)

If you can answer yes to the questions above, then you can trust God's word that you are saved!!

- *Don't trust your feelings, trust God's word. (Prov 3:5)
- *God's word is forever settled in heaven. (Ps 119:89)
- *You will never perish, and no one can remove you from God's hand. (John 10:28-30)
